

SPEAKER SYSTEMS

FRONT OF HOUSE: The system shall contain the appropriate amount of speakers, L-Acoustics, Meyer Lab, D&B (arrayed and tuned) and power amplifiers capable of covering all audience areas of the venue with clean, intelligible, undistorted sound and must be capable of minimum 100dbA average SPL at the Front of House mix position.

MONITORS: L-Acoustics, Meyer Lab, D&B, EAW, JBL. (12" - 2way w/ 2" exit large format compression driver), Bi-Amped. Supplemental Sub needed for drum wedge



TECHNICAL RIDER

SOUND NEEDS:

P.A.

- L'Acuostic, D&B or Adamson flown sound system if frontfill and delays are required to cover 100% of the capacity, the system needs to be accompanied by subwoofer chords in a number with the linearray system.
- Yamaha CL5 mixing console.
- The equipment must be assembled and adjusted upon the arrival of the company's technician.
- A minijack to play music, an SM58 for technician settings.

MONITORS:

- Monitors are part of FOH
- 3 floor monitors of the brands: L'Acoustic or D&B (12 inch IMPORTANT) in 2 shipments.
- 2 Sidefills of th brands: L'Acoustic or D&B in 1 shipment, placed on the front line of the stage.

We will take the DPAs, but not the rest.

The sound control must be in the stalls or central in the open air.

BACKLINE:

Acoustic grand piano: Steinway model D first option or Yamaha CFX or C7 second option. If due to the size of the stage it has to be a baby grand piano, these are the options: Steinway A as first option and Yamaha C5 or C6 as second option

Piano stool

The piano must be there on the arrival of the company's technician for placement and must be properly tuned to 442.

TECHNICAL RIDER

LIGHTING NEEDS

The attached lighting plan must be implemented in the respective format with the following clarifications:

- The technical personnel are required to deliver the entire equipment in perfect working order by the time the company's lighting technician arrives.
- A ladder, genie type system is imperative to enable personnel to climb up to focus / direct the conventional lighting elements in a safe manner.
- The Company will bring its own table, an Avolites Titan Mobile with four physical Dmx universes. In the event of working in Network (RJ45), notify beforehand to check nodes and protocols. The company should supply its own table to start up the equipment.
- Dimmer channels: 36
- 6 floor bases will be required.
- Black stage floor, with no marks or bands or carpeted in black for at least the first 8 metres.
- The entire black chamber must be opaque velvet in the same material.
- Fog: two hazer quality dmx adjustable and silent machines will be required. Four outdoor machines.
- Intercom: placed in lighting, sound, monitors and machinery / dimmer control.
- Lighting material: according to the plan.
- Brands accepted:
- PC: RJ, ADB, Spotlight
- Cuts: RJ, ETC SF (always zoom. In the event of having to replace with fixed angles, check beforehand).
- Dimmers: LT, ETC, ADB, Avolites

N.B: The lighting assembly can be adapted in cases of extreme need, always subject to the consent of the company's tour manager.
